



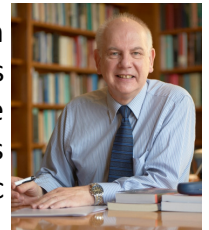
New Degree options at Spurgeon's College

The College was founded in 1856 by Charles Haddon Spurgeon, the greatest preacher of the Victorian era, whose sermons are still read by many around the world today.
