



Some wording you may find helpful

Suggested wording to leave a share of your estate (residuary legacy) to Spurgeon's College:

"Subject to the payment of my debts, funeral and testamentary expenses, I give the whole (residuary) or ___% of my estate not otherwise disposed of by this my Will to Spurgeon's College (Registered charity number 1096721 England/Wales) of 189 South Norwood Hill, London SE25 6DJ, for the general purposes of Spurgeon's College and I declare that the receipt of their Treasurer or other proper officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge."

Suggested wording to leave a specific sum (pecuniary legacy) to Spurgeon's College:

"I give free of tax to Spurgeon's College (Registered charity number 1096721 England/Wales) of 189 South Norwood Hill, London SE25 6DJ, the sum of £_____ for the general purposes of Spurgeon's College and I declare that the receipt of their Treasurer or other proper officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge."

Adding a codicil to your existing will

If you already have a will you can amend it at any time by adding a codicil, using the example wording below: "I (name) of (address) declare this to be the (first/second...) Codicil to my Will dated and made the (day) of (month), (year). In addition to any legacies given in my said Will I give the sum of £_____ (amount in figures & words) to Spurgeon's College (Registered charity number 1096721 England/Wales) of 189 South Norwood Hill, London SE25 6DJ, for the general purposes of Spurgeon's College and I declare that the receipt of their Treasurer or other proper officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge."

You can also leave a specific item, which could be something valuable such as an antique, painting, property or shares.
