Protocol for the admission of candidates to the Equipped for Digital Ministry programme

- This protocol document provides guidance for admission to the Equipped for Digital Ministry (EfDM) programme delivered via distance learning.
- 2. Admissions to the EfDM programme are the responsibility of the EfDM co-ordinator in conjunction with the Admissions Department.
- 3. No qualifications required to be admitted on to this programme.
- 4. This is a purely digital programme and can be studied from anywhere in the world. Therefore, there is no requirement for applicants to supply evidence that they are lawfully in the United Kingdom or in their own Country.
- 5. To be able to engage effectively with the programme, applicants should have a good understanding of the English Language, including the ability to read and write to a reasonable standard. Applicants may be required to demonstrate that they meet English language requirements prior to admission.
- 6. Student visas are not available for the EfDM progamme.
- 7. Applicants are strongly encouraged to disclose any disabilities, health issues whether physical or mental, or specific learning needs which might impact their studies. The College will make all reasonable adjustments for such students, but where there are concerns about a student's ability to undertake their desired programme, the procedures in the College's Fitness to Study policy are followed.
