



Visa Policy

1. Introduction

To apply for a visa to study at Spurgeon's College international students must have a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) issued by the College.

The College will provide the students with an Information sheet which outlines the visa process and how to apply; this will include the administration fee payable by all international applicants.

The College will assess the student's eligibility for a CAS and will consider the student's previous studies in the UK and whether they have a genuine intention to study the course they have applied for.

The earliest a student can apply for a visa is 3 months before the start of their course and a decision is usually given on their visa within 3 weeks.

The CAS number is only valid for one Tier 4 application. If the student's visa application is refused the College must be informed.

2. Process

An application to study must be submitted via UCAS (ucas.com)

3. Visa Guidelines

Please refer to UKVI website (<https://www.gov.uk/tier-4-general-visa/overview>) as new guidelines are updated and published regularly and there may be conflict in previous regulations.

Students applying for a Tier 4 visa to study in the UK will be required to follow UKVI guidelines.

The College will comply with UKVI guidelines as set out on the website.

4. Obligation

The College will confirm on annual basis the contact details of all visa students.
